**PRESCRIBED MANNER OF ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON  
THE GOVERNING COUNCIL AND SENATE.**

1. The Vice Chancellor shall appoint a date for the holding of a meeting for the election of member of Congregation to serve on the Council and other members to serve on the Senate, and all members of Congregation shall be entitled to vote.
2. The member elected to serve on the Council shall hold office for a period of four years and those elected to serve on the Senate shall each hold office for two years.
3. The representatives shall be elected by secret ballot after receipt, by the Registrar, of written nominations in respect of candidates who are qualified to be members of Congregation.
4. Congregation shall be entitled to elect any qualified candidate to serve on the Senate, so long as due regard is had to the desirability of ensuring as above, a representation as possible for the College, Faculties and Schools of the University.
5. Where, after the close of nominations, there is only one candidate duly nominated for the Council, such candidate shall be declared elected, without the taking of formal vote.
6. If there are two or more candidates nominated for the Council, the one who obtains the greater, or as the case may be, the greatest number of votes shall be declared by the person presiding, to be duly elected. Provided that in the event of a tie between two candidates, the person presiding shall have a casting vote for that purpose only.
7. If, after a first ballot, no candidate is declared elected, there shall be a further ballot until a candidate is declared elected in accordance with these regulations.
